Minutes of the Ordinary Committee Meeting held at 9.15am on Tuesday 11th February 2014 at the Council Offices, Valentine Road, Hunstanton.

1. Minutes of the Meeting held on 14th January 2014 were read and approved.
2. Secretary's Report was read and discussed.
3. Treasurer's Report was circulated. The current account stood at £1795.47, the deposit account at £7,400.70, total assts of £9196.17. In connection with the CCLA account mandate it was agreed that 2 of 3 signatures would be required from John Little, Andrew Murray and Martin Chown.
4. Discussion on the Heritage Centre Trust and Civic Day was deferred to the next meeting.
5. Britain in Bloom: Margi Blunden asked that thanks be expressed to those who attended the Signpost Garden clean up.
6. Progress on projects:
 - * Talks Evenings. MC reported on progress so far with organising talks for 2014/15
 - * Chapel Bank and Sea Front shelters: JL reported on the meeting with Rachel Fowler, Development officer of the Heritage Lottery Fund. MC reported on a meeting with Chris Bamfield (BKLWN) at which an undertaking to move the centre shelter was given.
 - * Input to Neighbourhood Plan: **Action:** TA to organise information for members to be available at a future Talks evening, with the opportunity for feedback.
 - * Updating and reprinting of interpretation boards: An urgent meeting to be called to push through any decision on funding by the Society since these were considered a priority. **Action:** MC to contact AM to arrange a.s.a.p.
 - * Discussion on leaflets, Ringstead Windmill and the formation of a Heritage Task Force was deferred to the next meeting.
7. Dates of next committee meetings: 11 March, 8th April.
8. AOB: MC brought forward a proposal for the commemoration of WW1 from MB that school children might be involved in researching names from the war memorial with a view to dramatic performance. This was supported and will need to be discussed with the relevant Head Teachers.
